An individual Treatment Plan (ITP) will be developed by therapist and the client. The ITP outlines long-term and short-term goals designed to address issues bringing you to treatment. When these goals have been successfully attained or there is evidence of successful progress towards attainment, the therapist and the client will negotiate a plan of discharge with a clear date of termination.

If an alternative treatment is sought at another agency or a different choice of treatment is requested that Produce Opportunities Which Embrace Rehabilitation, (POWER) LLC., Private Practice cannot provide, the above-referenced client will be discharged.

It is understood that if there is a period of 30-days or more without treatment, Produce Opportunities Which Embrace Rehabilitation, (POWER) LLC., will attempt to establish contact with the client via telephone and then, by written communication (i.e., letter, email, etc.). If you do not make contact, schedule, and keep an appointment within the time period requested, services will be terminated.

The therapist will make referrals to resources needed for the client, after discharge, if possible (i.e., if therapist is able to make contact with client), and therapist will document this in the clients' record.

You may be readmitted at any time in the future, but will need to go through a new intake process and be placed on a Client Commitment Contract.
